### The Lost Legions

The theme for the Heritage Open Days this year is anniversaries. It is exactly 2,000 years since the Seventeenth, Eighteenth and Nineteenth Legions were led by Varus into the Teutoburg forest in Germany and came to grief there. To commemorate the disaster we will be making standards to replace those of the lost legions.
